Dear Parish Family,

Today, fifty days after Easter, we celebrate the last day of the Easter Season! In the past, I have written about the beautiful sequence that many sing or recite for Pentecost. I invite you to pray it this week as a way of getting ready for two more feast days, Trinity Sunday and the Feast of the Body and Blood of Corpus Christi.

We also celebrate with those who came into the Church on Holy Saturday as they took part in their first fifty day of being fully Catholic and one with us. Join me in continuing to pray for them as their faith grows in our community.

I wish you all could be studying the Psalms with us on Wednesday evenings. Sister Marcia and I marvel at how much we are learning through all our adult formation opportunities.

I'd like to share a couple things that we have learned.

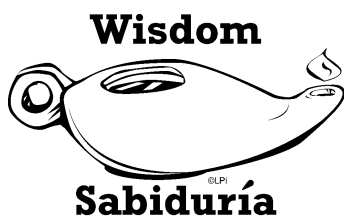
- First, children did you know that the Psalms are the only book of the Bible that is prayed everyday?
- They are the heart of our conversation with God. This is where God meets His children with great love and speaks to us. Just as infants learn the language of their parents, the Psalms are God's way of teaching us how to speak back to Him.
- The Psalms are quoted more in the New Testament than in the Old Testament, not just as prayers but they are the lens through which we see Jesus Christ as the King and Messiah.
- Why are the Responsorial Psalms so important to the Liturgy of the Mass? To understand, we must be aware that it is God who is speaking to us in the Sacred Scriptures not the reader or the lector. When God speaks to us, He teaches us. More importantly, He invites us into a relationship with Him. That initiation requires a response from all of us, not just the cantor or the choir. Each and every day the Responsorial Psalm is directly connected to the other sacred scriptures. St. Bernard's is blessed to have the Psalms sung so beautifully, but it is not "okay" for us just to listen or even be distracted during this time. I ask you to please follow along by singing what is written. It requires active participation from each of us, and how glorious would our voices be to God when we tell Him that we love, understand and accept his teachings.

As the Religious Education office breaks for the summer, you will find me here on Monday night for the Wellness class and Wednesday for Bible Study. I will be assisting Emily Kuh, our new Youth Minister Coordinator, with her responsibilities and the summer youth program.

I hope you will all sign up for at least Generations of Faith and one of the adult studies to show our youth how important life long learning is! Registration forms are at the entrances to the Church.
